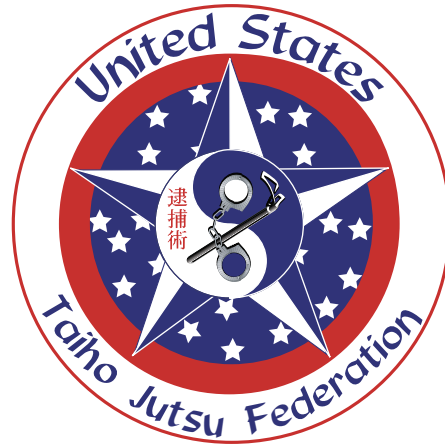

Taiho Jutsu combines techniques of Judo, Jujutsu, Aikido, Karate and other arts into a system that complements any previous training a person may have had in the Martial Arts or Specialized Defensive Tactics. It was developed by the Japanese police for law enforcement personnel. The techniques presented are an effective means of

controlling passive resistors and combative aggressors within the guidelines of the law. They allow the participant to transition into a variety of techniques in order to stop any unacceptable behavior.
